



- Input: "this is necessary"
- Dictionary:
 - []{}""(BLK)<eng,o,o>;
 - [this]{}""(LEX=D,POS=DEM,att=@proximal) <eng,o,o>;
 - [this]{}""(LEX=R,POS=DEP,att=@proximal)<eng,o,o>;
 - [is]{}""(LEX=I,POS=AUX) <eng,o,o>;
 - [is]{}""(LEX=V,POS=COP) <eng,o,o>;
 - [necessary]{}""(LEX=N,POS=NOU) <eng,o,o>;
 - [necessary]{}""(LEX=J,POS=ADJ) <eng,o,o>;
- Tokenization
 - (this,D)(BLK)(is,I)(BLK)(necessary,N)
- D-Grammar
 - (D)(BLK)(I)=o;
 - (this,D)(BLK)(**is,V**)(BLK)(necessary,N)
 - (D)(BLK)(I)=o; (D)(BLK)(V)=o;
 - (**this,R**)(BLK)(**is,V**)(BLK)(necessary,N)



Morphology

Analysis

- Inflectional
 - party>parties
 - (PLR,[^]@pl):= (+att=@pl);
 - go>went
 - (PAS,[^]@past):= (+att=@past);
- Agglutinative
 - the book
 - ("the",%x) ("book",%y):= (%y,+att=@def);
 - male teacher
 - ("male",%x) ("teacher",%y):= (%y,+att=@male);

Observations

- Generalization (1)
 - ("the",%x)("book",%y):=(%y,+att=@def);
 - ("the",%x)("girl",%y):=(%y,+att=@def);
 - ("the",%x)("table",%y):=(%y,+att=@def);
 - ...
 - ("the",%x)(N,%y):=(%y,+att=@def);
- Generalization (2)
 - ("the",%x)(N,%y):=(%y,+att=@def);
 - ("a",%x)(N,%y):=(%y,+att=@indef);
 - ("all",%x)(N,%y):=(%y,+att=@all);
 - ...
 - (D,%x)(N,%y):=(%y,+att=%x);

Examples from English (I)

- All human beings are born free and equal in dignity and rights.
 - all + human beings = human beings.@all
 - ("all",%x)("human beings",%y):=(%y,+att=@all);
 - (D,%x)(N,%y):=(%y,+att=%x);
 - human beings = human beings.@pl
 - rights = rights.@pl
 - (N,PLR,^@pl):= (+att=@pl);

Examples from English (II)

- They are endowed with reason and conscience and should act towards one another in a spirit of brotherhood.
 - should + act = act.@obligation
 - ("should",%x)(V,%y):=(%y,+att=@obligation);
 - (MOV,%x)(V,%y):=(%y,+att=%x);
 - a + spirit = spirit.@indef
 - (D,%x)(N,%y):=(%y,+att=%x);

Examples from English (III)

- Everyone is entitled to all the rights and freedoms set forth in this Declaration, without distinction of any kind, such as race, colour, sex, language, religion, political or other opinion, national or social origin, property, birth or other status.
 - rights = rights.@pl
 - freedoms = freedoms.@pl
 - (N,PLR,[^]@pl):= (+att=@pl);
 - any + kind = kind.@any
 - other + opinion = opinion.@other
 - other + status = status.@other
 - this + declaration = declaration.@proximal
 - (D,%x)(N,%y):=(%y,+att=%x);

Examples from English (IV)

- Furthermore, no distinction shall be made on the basis of the political, jurisdictional or international status of the country or territory to which a person belongs, whether it be independent, trust, non-self-governing or under any other limitation of sovereignty.
 - no + distinction = distinction. @no
 - the + country = country. @def
 - a + person = person. @indef
 - other + limitation = limitation. @other
 - any + limitation = limitation. @any
 - ($D, \%x)(N, \%y) := (\%y, +att = \%x);$
 - shall + be = be. @obligation
 - ("shall", $\%x)(V, \%y) := (\%y, +att = @obligation);$
 - ($MOV, \%x)(V, \%y) := (\%y, +att = \%x);$
 - non + - + self-governing = self-governing. @not
 - ("non")("-")($J, \%x) := (\%x, +att = @not);$
 - the political, jurisdictional or international status = status. @def

Examples from English (V)

- Everyone has the right to life, liberty and security of person.
 - the + right = right.@def
 - $(D, \%x)(N, \%y) := (\%y, +att = \%x);$
- No one shall be held in slavery or servitude;
 - shall + be = be.@obligation
 - $(MOV, \%x)(V, \%y) := (\%y, +att = \%x);$
- slavery and the slave trade shall be prohibited in all their forms.
 - the + slave = slave.@def
 - $(D, \%x)(N, \%y) := (\%y, +att = \%x);$
 - shall + be = be.@obligation
 - $(MOV, \%x)(V, \%y) := (\%y, +att = \%x);$
 - all their forms

Examples from English (VI)

- No one shall be subjected to torture or to cruel, inhuman or degrading treatment or punishment.
 - shall + be = be. @obligation
 - $(MOV, \%x)(V, \%y) := (\%y, +att=\%x);$

Generation

- Inflectional
 - party.@pl>parties
 - (@pl):= (+NUM=PLR, -@pl);
 - go.@past>went
 - (@past):= (+ATE=PAS, -@past);
- Agglutinative
 - book.@def = the book
 - (%x,@def):= ("the")(" ")(%x,-@def);
 - teacher.@male = male teacher
 - (%x,@male):= ("male")(" ")(%x,-@male);

Agreement

■ Gender & Number

- livre.@def = le livre
- table.@def = la table
- livre.@def.@pl = les livres
- table.@def.@pl = les tables
 - (%x,@def,^@pl,^PLR,MCL):=("le")(" ")(%x,-@def);
 - (%x,@def,^@pl,^PLR,FEM):=("la")(" ")(%x,-@def);
 - (%x,@def,PLR):=("les")(" ")(%x,-@def,-@pl);

Examples from English (I)

- human beings.@all are born free and equal in dignity and right.@pl. They are endowed with reason and conscience and act.@obligation towards one another in spirit.@indef of brotherhood.
 - (%x,N,@all):=("all")(" ")(%x,-@all,+@pl);
 - (N,@pl,^PLR):=(o>"s",-@pl,+PLR);
 - (N,@pl,PLR):=(-@pl);
 - (%x,V,@obligation):=("shall")(" ")(%x,-@obligation)
 - (%x,N,@indef):=("a")(" ")(%x,-@indef);

Examples from English (II)

- Everyone is entitled to right.@all.@def.@pl and freedom.@pl set forth in Declaration.@proximal, without distinction of kind.@any, such as race, colour, sex, language, religion, political or opinion.@other, national or social origin, property, birth or status.@other.
 - (%x,N,@def):= ("the")(" ")(%x,-@def);
 - (%x,N,@proximal,^PLR,^@pl):= ("this")(" ")(%x,-@proximal);
 - (%x,N,@any):= ("any")(" ")(%x,-@any)
 - (%x,N,@other):= ("other")(" ")(%x,-@other);

Examples from English (III)

- Furthermore, distinction.@no
be.@obligation made on the basis of the political, jurisdictional or international status of country.@def or territory to which person.@indef belongs, whether it be independent, trust, self-governing.@not or under limitation.@any.@other of sovereignty.
 - (%x,N,@no):=("no")(" ")(%x,-@no);
 - (%x,J,@not):=("not")("-")(%x,-@not);

English Morphology (Generation)

- (N,@pl,^PLR):=(o>"s",-@pl,+PLR);
- (N,@pl,PLR):=(-@pl);
- (%x,N,@all):=("all")(" ")(%x,-@all,+@pl);
- (%x,N,@indef):=("a")(" ")(%x,-@indef);
- (%x,N,@def):=("the")(" ")(%x,-@def);
- (%x,N,@proximal,^PLR,^@pl):=("this")(" ")(%x,-@proximal);
- (%x,N,@any):=("any")(" ")(%x,-@any)
- (%x,N,@other):=("other")(" ")(%x,-@other);
- (%x,N,@no):=("no")(" ")(%x,-@no);
- (%x,J,@not):=("not")("-")(%x,-@not);
