Exercise #2 - N-Grammar

- Goal: To prepare the N-grammar for the training corpus
- Deliverables:
 - o ngrammar_<ID>.txt
 - o corpus_seg_<ID>.txt
- Activities:
 - 1. Read the instructions available at www.unlweb.net/wiki/N-rule
 - 2. Analyze the English N-grammar available at UNLWEB>UNLARIUM>GRAMMAR>ENGLISH>GRAMMARS>NORMALIZATION>N.1
 - 3. Create a N-grammar (ngrammar_<ID>.txt) necessary to
 - a) Normalize the abbreviations and contractions appearing in your training corpus
 - b) Segment your training corpus in sentences
 - 4. Upload the N-grammar to the UTK (UNLWEB>UNLDEV>UTK>CORPUS>N-GRAMMAR>ADD)
 - 5. Segment your training corpus:
 - a) UNLWEB>UNLDEV>UTK>CORPUS>CORPUS>LOAD [YOUR CORPUS]
 - b) UNLWEB>UNLDEV>UTK>CORPUS>N-GRAMMAR>LOAD [YOUR N-GRAMMAR]
 - c) UNLWEB>UNLDEV>UTK>CORPUS>PROCESS>SEGMENT
 - 6. Check the results and do the necessary changes until the normalization and segmentation are correct
 - 7. Export the resulted segmented text as *corpus_seg_<ID>.txt*
